Women in Mabou stay put

A local town looking to get involved in a CBC reality show has not been chosen.

The town of Mabou will not be the site of Season 2's "The Week the Women Went" as Tatamagouche was selected by Vancouver-based Paperny Films on Tuesday.

The company says the deciding factor was higher enthusiasm levels in Tatamagouche.

The premise explores what happens when all the women in town pack up and leave for a week and leave the men and children to fend for themselves.

Partner of Paperny Films Cal Shumiatcher says despite the decision, his production staff thought highly of Mabou.

"I don't think they were embellishing, they said Mabou is probably the most beautiful place they've ever seen. For that reason one of the jokes they were saying is if I were a woman in Mabou I wouldn't want to leave because it's so beautiful here."

Filming will start in September of 2008 and the show will air in January of 2009.
